						<ul> <li>WORK SESSION SUMMARY</li> <li>Ms. Amy Attwood, District 51 Lobbyist</li> <li>Mrs. Attwood is a lobbyist retained by the Board to act on their behalf and represent District 51's interests at the state capital in relation to legislation. Mrs. Attwood shared a summary of last year's legislative session and discussed the direction for the upcoming year. Discussion took place on legislation from last year. State assessments will be studied by an appointed task force consisting of administrators, school boards, parents, teachers, a senator and a speaker from the house. Recommendations will be brought to the legislature by January 31, 2015. Mrs. Attwood will update the Board on the progress of this committee as it is available. Discussion took place regarding the physical limitations regarding equipment needed to participate in the state required testing. Discussion took place regarding possible upcoming legislation on Common Core. Mrs. Attwood stated there is a large parent push against Common Core. Mrs. Attwood discussed the negative factor and the ramifications for Mesa County Valley School District 51. Mr. Parrish asked about the Amendment 23 lawsuit. Mrs. Attwood stated it is difficult to predict the outcome of this lawsuit. In discussing other funding Mrs. Attwood stated the BEST Program is about gone; the marijuana tax revenue is unestimated and districts across the state of Colorado are struggling with capital needs. She also reported there is a new law in which if a district has a mill levy, they must have a discussion with Charter School Boards and tell them why they are not including them; or give them the option to be added to the ballot.</li> <li>▶ The Board and Superintendent thanked Ms. Attwood for the information.</li> <li>[Mr. Mikolai called for a Break at 6:45 p.m. Meeting Resumed at 7:52 p.m.]</li> </ul>	6:20 p.m.

	<ol> <li>Discipline Committee Action Plan</li> <li>Mr. Schultz introduced Mrs. Susana Wittrock, Executive Director; Mr. Tony Giurado, Chief Academic Officer; Mr. Jason Eidinger, Assistant Principal; and Mrs. Cathy Haller, Prevention Services Coordinator who represented the Board appointed Discipline Committee. They presented an action plan which describes how the committee, District 51 and staff will move forward to address discipline issues and what steps they will take to provide support to teachers and staff. Below are the action goals they discussed:         <ul> <li>Promote shared responsibility for student learning through students, schools, families and community members working together by creating a safe secure learning environment and building consistency across the District for behavioral expectations for students; and teaching those expectations.</li> <li>Promote shared responsibility for student learning through students, schools, families, and community members working together with all buildings, developing a PBIS team. This team will meet monthly to review discipline and other data. This will help inform and target interventions and behavior data, with both minor and major incidents being entered into Synergy.</li> <li>Promote shared responsibility for student learning through students, schools, families and community members while working together in District 51. A work group will be created to consult on the development of a level system program in Severe Needs Behavior (SNB) classrooms at the elementary level, to help reduce problem behaviors in the regular education environment.</li> </ul></li></ol> <li>Mr. Mikolai reported visiting schools with Mr. Schultz and Mr. Giurado on the first day of school. He praised Mr. Odus Harwood, Executive Director of Instructional Technology for his attention to detail and problem solving on the first day of school.</li>
