

Gifted and Talented Procedures for Disagreements

- 1. It is the intent of the Mesa County Valley School District 51 to resolve questions and concerns at the level at which they occurred. All questions and concerns regarding Gifted and Talented identification and services should be brought first to school personnel (classroom teachers, Gifted and Talented Teacher or Liaison, and school administration).
- 2. If the parents/guardians are not satisfied with the resolution at the school level, they may submit their disagreement in writing to the Student Support Services and Gifted Education office by emailing Summer.Allen@d51schools.org or calling (970) 254-6903 for instructions on how to submit the disagreement in writing. Parents/guardians will be notified of the next steps in writing by email (if email is provided) or by mail. Please allow 10 school days for resolution and/or next steps to be determined.
- 3. If the parents/guardians are not satisfied with the resolution from the Gifted Education office, they may submit their disagreement in writing to Parent Resolution & Support by emailing Amanda.Moyer@d51schools.org or calling (970) 254-5311 for instructions to submit the disagreement in writing. Parents/guardians will be notified of the next steps in writing by email (if email is provided) or by mail. Please allow 10 school days for resolution and/or next steps to be determined.
- 4. If the parents/guardians are not satisfied with the resolution from the Parent Resolution & Support office, they may submit their disagreement in writing to the Superintendent by emailing Amy.Navarette@d51schools.org or calling (970) 254-5193 for instructions to submit the disagreement in writing. Parents/guardians will be notified of the decision in writing by email (if email is provided) or by mail. Please allow 10 school days for the resolution to be determined.
